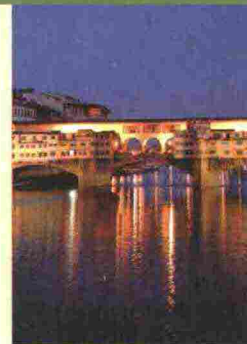

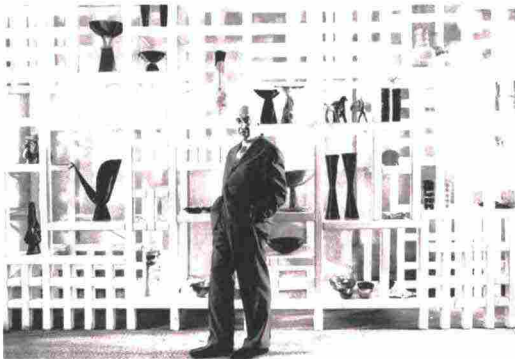


Listings are arranged thematically and offer a selection of the most interesting events each month.
